

Indiana Parenting Time Guidelines

Here is a brief summary of the standard parenting time ordered in Porter County, Indiana which reflects the minimum recommended time a parent should have to maintain frequent, meaningful, and continuing contact with a child. For children 3 years of age and older, the non-custodial parent should have parenting time on alternating weekends from Friday at 6:00 p.m. until Sunday at 6:00 p.m., and on evening per week for up to 4 hours. Generally, the non-custodial parent will also exercise parenting time for half of the summer vacation. Intricate rules apply regarding notice and timing of summer parenting time, but Rhame & Elwood can help you navigate those fine points.
